- Services for underwater systems, such as localization, synchronization, navigation, security, etc.
- Communication & coordination for underwater vehicles and sensor nodes, or human operator interaction
- Coordinated energy harvesting systems and power systems for underwater networks and systems
- Energy-efficient algorithms, and protocol design for underwater networks and systems
- Operating system and middleware support for underwater networks and systems
- Applications that broadly address underwater networks and systems, including coordinated underwater vehicles
- Modeling, simulation, and testbeds for underwater systems and platforms
- Experimental results from underwater field trials & tests
- Application requirements for underwater networks and systems presented by end users

Submission Guidelines

Submissions for technical papers must describe original research, not published in other workshops, conferences, journals, or magazines. The conference accepts full, short papers and extended abstracts. It will also include a work-in-progress poster/demo session which allows a much later submission.
